BIBLE STORY

Read Matthew 4, John 1, and Matthew 9. In order to follow Jesus, the disciples had to leave everything behind and give Jesus their all. What are you willing to give?



BIBLE VERSE

Ecclesiastes 9:10a
This week's verse tells us that we should give God our very best in every area of our life.



HALF WAY DAY

Pick one day this week and name it 'Half Way Day.' At any point during the day, any member of the family can choose to not give it their all. They may only pick up half their room, or drive half way to practice or stop after making half of dinner. At this point, the other members of the family have to cheer each other on to give it their all! The family member not giving it their all then gets to continue their project and give it their all!



GAME DAY

Play a board game, card game or an outdoor game together as a family. At some point during the game, the parent will purposefully stop giving it their all. They may give up and sit down, or just stop rolling the dice or stop dealing the cards. Once it's obvious that the game is not going well, stop the game and explain how important it is that each person give it their all. Now, continue the game. This time, each member of the family gives it their all!
