I WILL SEE PEOPLE AS GOD SEES THEM!

FAMILY DEVOTIONAL

Our Bible Verse this week is 1 Samuel 16:7b. This verse tells us to look at people the way God sees them.

In our Bible Story, Jesus teaches us we should see others the way He sees them. Read John 4:5-42 with your child.

COOKIE PEOPLE

Roll out some cookie dough and have each family member use a butter knife to carve out a person-shaped cookie. Have them make each person look different. Some can be sitting, some standing, some running, some playing sports, some tall, some short, some round, some skinny. When the cookies are ready to eat call the family together and share some cookies. Ask the family if the cookies taste different from each other, or if they are the same. The cookies look different, but taste the same because we made them that way. God made us all different, but on the inside, we are all the same and He loves each person the same. Encourage your family not to judge people based on outward appearance, but to treat all people with love because God made everyone special and He loves them.

GOD-D

Watch a 3D movie together as a family. Pause the movie at some point and have everyone take off the 3D glasses. Watch a short part of the movie and discuss how blurry and strange everything looks. Tell your family that we don't see people in "God-D," the way God does. Our eyes only see part of the picture and we can't see people as they really are. Tell them that just like putting the 3D glasses on helps us see the movie the way it's supposed to be seen, remembering that God loves all people the same helps us see others the way they are supposed to be seen. Remind your family to see others as people who are loved by God and to treat others with love because God loves them. Have everyone put the glasses back on and finish the movie.
