BIBLE STUDY

Read Luke 18:1-8. From Jesus' story of the persistent widow we learn never to give up praying, even when we don't get an answer immediately. By persistently praying we will grow closer to God and also become more comfortable in praying. What are some things that you need to continue to pray for?

BIBLE VERSE

1 Thessalonians 5:17

This week's verse tells us God desires for us to be faithful and persistent in our prayers.

PERSISTENT PRAYER

Set up a time each day this week to pray together as a family. Openly share requests and pray for each other's needs. It is ok to pray for the same request several days in a row. Throughout the week, discuss what it means to never give up praying. Explain how we don't pray persistently to pester God into what we want, but God wants us to talk with Him on an ongoing basis to get to know Him better. Also, the more we talk with God, the more comfortable we will be when we pray.
