MAIN POINT: JESUS IS A GOOD FRIEND!

Create two paper signs, one should say "Jesus is" and the other should say "A Good Friend". Put them at opposite ends of a large room or the yard. Try some silly races to see who can get from "Jesus is" to "A Good Friend" the fastest. For example: hopping, crawling, skipping, elephant walk, etc.

BIBLE VERSE: John 15:13 "There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends." NLT

READ THE BIBLE STORY TOGETHER: The Death of Jesus (Mark 15:33-41 or Luke 23:44-49 or John 19:28-37)

SHARE YOUR STORY

Share with your child the story of when you accepted Jesus. Keep it simple. Just focus on these three things: a little of what your life was like before you knew about Jesus, the event or time where you accepted Jesus, and the change in your life since you accepted Jesus. Reinforce that sin is just another word for all the bad things we do that God doesn't want us to do, like lying or cheating, or disobeying our parents. Remind your child that Jesus died for our sins so that all our sins would be taken away. Jesus laid down His life for each of us and he wants each person to be His friend.
