

Remind your family that we all need to tell the truth at all times, but we especially need to tell the truth about Jesus, like the blind man who was healed in John chapter 9. To help them remember this, go for a drive and play "Spell It And Tell It," a game where you find the letters that spell truth and tell something true from the Bible or about God. Everyone in the car watches for the letters T-R-U-T-H on signs or vehicles as you drive. Letters must be seen by at least one other player and must be called in the correct order. Once someone has called a letter from a sign or vehicle, no one else can call a letter from that same source. After calling out a letter and where it is, players have to say something true about God or from the Bible. For example: "God loves us," or "Jesus fed 5000 people." The first person to spell truth is the winner. To make the game harder, you can make a rule that the letter being called has to be at the beginning of a word.

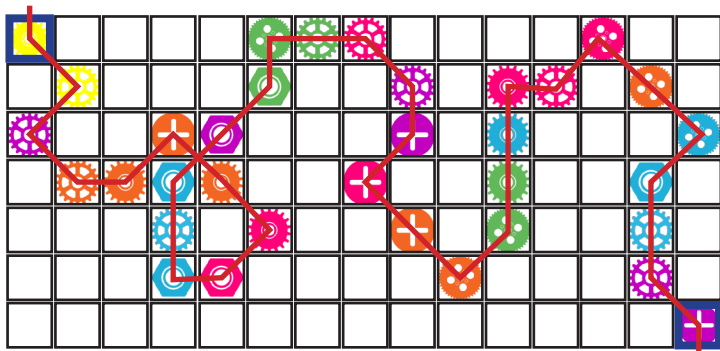

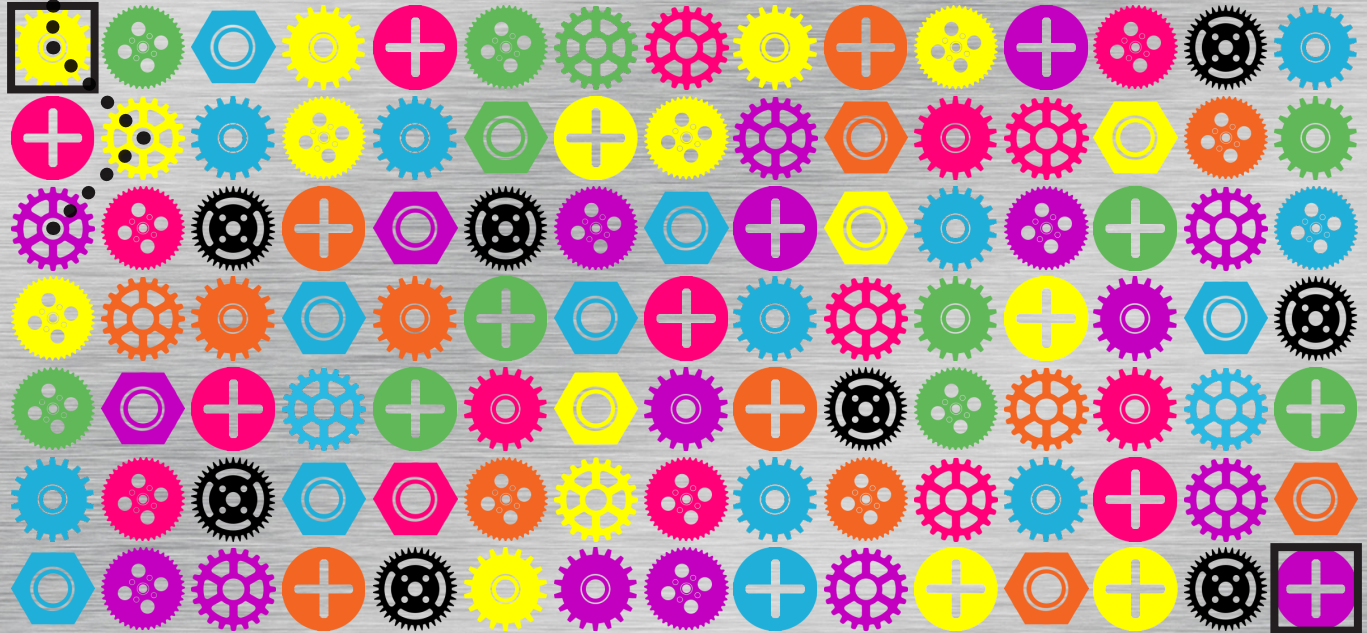

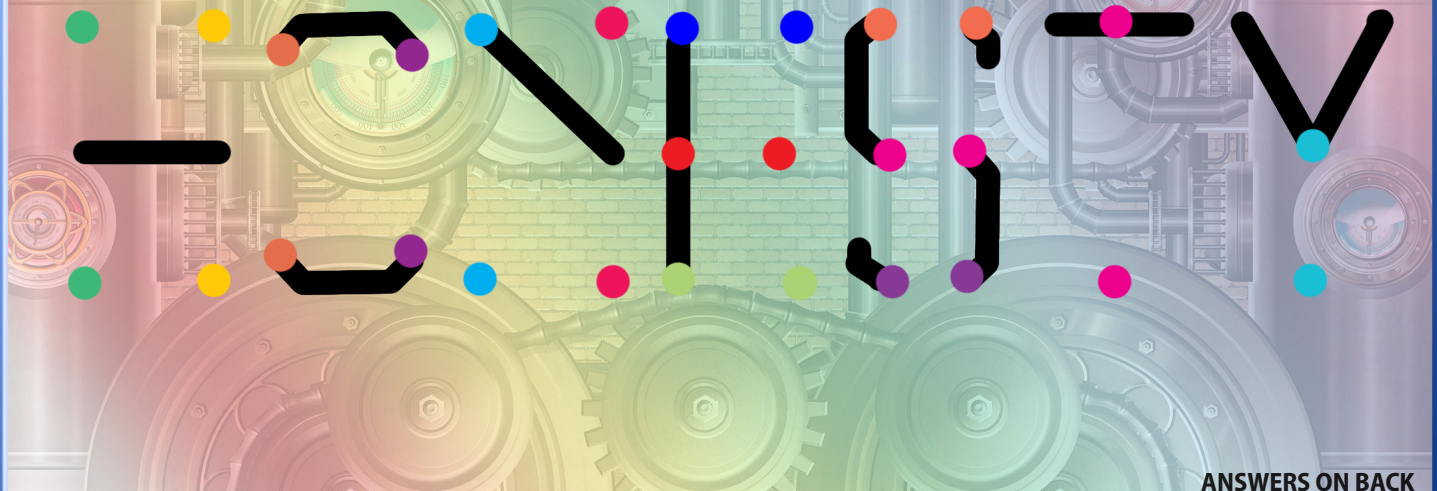
